

## From Penneshaw Ferry Terminal (90 Min/130 km): See A on Map

- Drive up the hill from the ferry terminal and along the coast.
- Stay on Hog Bay Road, passing both Pelican Lagoon and the turn off to American River on your right. Continue until you reach a "T" junction. This is the intersection with Elsegood Road and is 48 km from the ferry.
- At this point turn right and almost immediately left onto Arranmore Road, towards Kingscote Airport.
- After 4 km Kingscote Airport is on your left. The airport has excellent public facilities accessible during business hours.
- Follow directions from Kingscote Airport.

## Driving on Kangaroo Island

A few tips to driving on the island dubbed 'the zoo without fences'

- Fill up with petrol before 6pm and ensure you have a generous supply.
- Watch for wildlife on the road: Dawn and dusk - feeding time Night - travelling time Day - sleeping time
- Drive carefully as many roads are unsealed.
- Kangaroo Island is a rural community so you may encounter farm machinery, trucks, and even livestock being moved on the roads.
- In short expect the unexpected.

## From Kingscote Airport (50 Min/80 km):

- Drive out of the airport and turn left onto Arranmore Road. Less than a kilometre down the road you will come to a "T" junction - turn left towards Flinders Chase.
- After 44 km you will pass Vivonne Bay where there is a General Store on the left.
- Continue heading west for another 30 km when you will see Hanson Bay Road on the left - there is a blue "Southern Ocean Lodge" sign on the street post. Up until this point the road has been a high standard sealed road. Hanson Bay Road is unsealed and can be corrugated and dusty.
- After 3.5 km the main entrance gate to Southern Ocean Lodge will be obvious on the right. Simply press the intercom button and you will be connected to reception for entry.
- It is then a short 3 km drive through the native bushland to the lodge.
