SERVICES & FACILITIES

Activities

The lodge offers a range of signature experiences to help you relax and discover the lodge and surrounds at vour own pace. Complimentary activities include guided walks, river swimming and snorkelling, yoga and access to mountain bikes, river kayaks and the gymnasium. The lodge also offers a daily shuttle transfer to Port Douglas. It's best to plan ahead to make the most of vour time and the Reception team is available to assist with bookings either on arrival or during your stay.

Check In/Check Out

Check in time is 2pm and check out time is 10.30am. The lodge facilities are available for your enjoyment whilst at the property.

Housekeeping

Daily suite housekeeping generally occurs between 8.30am and 4.30pm. Should you prefer a particular time for your treehouse to be serviced, please advise Reception. An evening turndown service is also offered.

Internet

Laundry

A complimentary guest laundry facility is located on the lower level of the main lodge near the pool. A same-day laundry service is also available; please contact Reception if you require your laundry to be collected from your treehouse.

Mini Bar

Power

Domestic power supply is 240 volts. Adaptors are available from Reception on loan or for purchase in the boutique.

Telephone

A telephone is located in your treehouse, giving you direct dial access for long distance calls within Australia (STD) and international (ISD) calls. Please refer to the Telephone Guide for information or dial 9 for further assistance.

Time Difference

Silky Oaks Lodge operates on Australian Eastern Standard Time (+10 hours Greenwich mean time) all year. There are no daylight savings in Queensland.

Walking Attire

Comfortable enclosed shoes and light-weight active wear are recommended.

Please sign out with Reception prior to beginning your walk and avoid commencing trails after 5pm.

Activity Essentials

A hat, sunscreen, personal insect repellent and swimsuit (for swimming along the Fig Tree Rapids Trails) and plenty of drinking water.

Keep to the Trail

It's very easy to get disoriented; please take care as hiking trails can become slippery in parts.

River Kayaking

Always wear a life vest (available from Reception) when kayaking. Kayaks are designed for calm waters and use is subject to river conditions - please check with Reception. Please consider your swimming competency carefully before use; use of kayaks is not permitted after dark.
